#### **Financial**

**2019 Budget/ P&L YTD**: The proposed budget for 2019 was presented to the membership. After lengthy discussion a motion was made by Charles Newcomb, seconded by Brian Boulris and unanimously to approve the assessments for the coming year, which will be increased to \$572.00 annually or \$143.00 per quarter. Customers who paid \$528 in 2018 will have a credit to be used towards the 2019 fee which will show on their first statement.

**Board Member Comments:** Marilyn mentioned that the sidewalk repairs in the park will be completed in 2019.

#### **Community Comments:**

Recently there have been car break ins in the neighborhood. Residents should make sure their vehicles are locked at all times. The association has requested that a new street light be added to the corner of Bramley Lane for additional security.

If residents see street lights out they should call the City of Deland to report it.

An owner mentioned the possibility of flashing lights for the stop signs. The manager will check in to it.
